LRIP & TRID projects for 2021- updates: Monarch will start pulverizing on Monday 23, they expect it to take 2 days, installation of culverts will start Wednesday 25.

Approve contract with Monarch for 310th and 130th St: Motion by Tischer to accept contract for \$ 9,079.90, Supervisor Taylor second, carried.

Approve contract with County for culverts installed on 330th Ave: Chris reported that Polk County and the DNR are discussing the culvert installations, Supervisor Taylor motioned to be tabled until June meeting, seconded by Supervisor Tischer.

Road inspection report: Sink hole in middle of road on 310th by Roedl's. Many areas need shouldering updated. Possible crack and chip sealing of 170th. Possible grind 140th by 310th. 325th breaking up.

Adopt resolution regarding Northland Ambulance: Glenn attended the Q&A meeting at Brow Tine and shared information discussed. Motion Supervisor Taylor to support going forward with the discussions regarding merger details, second by Supervisor Tischer, to adopt resolution 2021-3, carried.

Approve 2022 contract for Prochnow Assessing: Motion by Supervisor Taylor to accept contract for \$8300 for 3 years to reassess the town, Supervisor Tischer, 2nd, carried.

Employee/Highway Report: Chris reported that tractor tires are here, will be delivering tractor to Alpha Tire to be installed. Helped Clam Falls township with installing 3 culverts.

Correspondence: Notice from DNR that 36 acres will be going into the MFL program.

Review bills/pay: Motion made by Supervisor Taylor, seconded by Supervisor Tischer to approve the payment of bills check# 17578 to 17593, payroll and ACH payments totaling \$70,669.25. Motion Supervisor Tischer, to change fees for liquor license to one half due to COVID related loss of income, seconded by Supervisor Taylor.
