

Town of West Sweden Public Budget Hearing and Special Town Meeting of Electors

Public Budget Hearing – November 18, 2025

The Public Budget Hearing for the Town of West Sweden was called to order by Chairman Bruce Lundquist at 6:00 PM. Attendees included Chairman Bruce Lundquist, Supervisors Terry Taylor and Craig Swanberg, Treasurer Lori Lundquist, and Clerk Phyllis Wilder. Residents in attendance were Jerry Tischer, while the nonresidents present included Chris Tewalt and Carl Thomföhrda.

Public Notice

The clerk posted the official public notice for this meeting at multiple locations to ensure community awareness. Notices were placed at the West Sweden Town Hall, the town website, the Frederic Post Office, and the Frederic Public Library on October 30, 2025. Additionally, the notice was reposted on November 17, 2025 at the Town Hall and town website.

Budget Review

During the meeting, the clerk reviewed the proposed budget for the year 2026 with the residents present. After the review, Supervisor Swanberg made a motion to adjourn the hearing.

Chairman Lundquist seconded the motion, and it was carried unanimously.

The hearing was officially adjourned at 6:05 PM.

Special Town Meeting of Electors

Immediately following the budget hearing, the Special Town Meeting of Electors was called to order at 6:06 PM by Chairman Bruce Lundquist. The meeting was attended by Chairman Lundquist, Supervisors Taylor and Swanberg, Treasurer Lundquist, Clerk Wilder, and resident Jerry Tischer. Non-residents were Chris Tewalt and Carl Thomföhrda.

The clerk confirmed that the public notice for the Special Town Meeting was posted at the West Sweden Town Hall, Frederic Post Office, Frederic Public Library, and on the town website on October 30, 2025. It was reposted on November 17, 2025 at the Town Hall and town website to ensure public awareness.

Clerk Phyllis Wilder presented the proposed levy for 2025 taxes, which are due in 2026, recommending an adjusted total amount of \$304,025 as proposed by the board. Craig Swanberg motioned to adopt Resolution 2025-04, endorsing the Town Board's Resolution 2024-03 to exceed the levy limit. Chairman Lundquist seconded the motion. The resolution was approved with six ayes and zero nays.

Lori Lundquist then motioned to adopt Resolution 2025-06, which established the total town levy at \$304,025. Jerry Tischer seconded the motion, and it was carried by a unanimous voice vote of six ayes and zero nays.

With no further business, Chairman Lundquist adjourned the meeting at 6:12 PM.
