The clerk presented the May meeting minute, motion Supervisor Taylor to approve minutes, Chairman Lundquist seconded, carried.

The treasurer presented the May financial report, motion Supervisor Taylor to approve financial report, Chairman Lundquist seconded, motion carried.

Open bids for crack/chip sealing of 160th Street:

Fahrner Crack fill \$8658 Chipseal \$27,045

SealTech Inc: Chipseal \$3500, second option \$2,800. Discussion on options.

Motion Supervisor Taylor to accept chipseal bid from Fahrner for \$8658, seconded Chairman Lundquist, motion carried. Motion Supervisor Taylor accept Scott Construction chip seal, seconded Chairman Lundquist, motion carried.

Glenn Meier subdivision: Mr Meier presented a proposal to subdivide his 39 acres requesting approval from the board to process. Board approved.

Public Input: Jerry Tischer presented a letter to the Board expressing concerns regarding when the board decides to change the road structures on roads that the residents be notified of the change prior to it happening.
