

TOWN OF WEST SWEDEN-Monthly meeting August 19, 2025

Chairman Lundquist called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm. Present were Craig Swanberg supervisor, Phyllis Wilder, clerk, Chris Tewalt, patrolman. Terry Taylor and Lori Lundquist were absent. Also present: Judy Hammond and Vanessa Neuman residents, Jon Everson from Wagner Surveying, Jason Jensen, and Justin Jensen from Crex Property Rehab.

The clerk presented the July meeting minutes, motion Chairman Lundquist to approve minutes, Supervisor Swanberg seconded, minutes approved.

The clerk presented the July financial report in the absence of the treasurer, motion Chairman Lundquist to approve financial report, Supervisor Swanberg seconded, motion carried.

Subdivisions:

3341 130th St- Justin Jensen-presented map of subdivide 3 parcels and provided explanation of plans for property, was missing proper documents for board to sign off on. Will come to September meeting.
3074 170th St- Jon Everson of Wagner Surveying presented certified map and documents for the 6.5 acres subdivision of Hamond's property. Chairman Lundquist motioned to approve, Supervisor Swanberg seconded, motion carried.

Unfinished Business

Road Work update: Chris reported the rock chips are delivered to 160th Street. Estimates for repairs to 150th Street at Diamond Lake are \$54,000 asphalt and curb, Nick's estimate was \$11,000 for rip wrap and rock. The clerk received communication from WTA on separate ways to do the road work. Chairman Lundquist will check with civil engineer for recommendations for repairs. Monarch provided a quote of \$84,000 to blacktop the western portion of 345th Avenue that does not include shouldering or base.

150th Anniversary of the Town wrap up: Board was happy with the event. A reporter from the Inter Count Leader took pictures, and an article will appear in an issue of the paper.

New Business

Fall workshops: Bruce Lundquist will attend the WTA fall town & village workshop on September 17 in Cable.

Schedule road planning meeting: Date set for Wednesday, September 10 at 6 pm. Five worst roads are 340th to 180th, Clam Falls Drive, 140th to Clam Falls Drive, 180th from Hwy 48 to Pole Cat Crossing, 345th Avenue.

Employee/Highway report: Chris reported that culverts have been replaced on Clam Falls Drive, and that 140th St culvert by Lance Williamsons is failing.

Closed session: A motion was made by Supervisor Swanberg, seconded by Chairman Lundquist to convene into closed session at 6:40 pm, pursuant to Wis Stat 19.85(1)(c) for purposing of considering employment, promotion, compensation, or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the governmental body has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility.

Supervisor Swanberg made the motion to reconvene to open session seconded by Chairman Lundquist seconded, carried.

Result of closed session: Supervisor Swanberg motion to raise wages for both full time and part time patrolman, Chairman Lundquist seconded, motion carried.

Review/pay bills: Motion Chairman Lundquist to approve the payment of bills check#18397-18414, payroll, ACH payments totaling \$124,464.98 Supervisor Swanberg seconded. Carried.
